Type of Organization:		An independent agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
Enabling Legislation:		Act 16 of 1988, The Pennsylvania Infrastructure Authority Act.
Purpose:		To give low-interest loans (1-5 percent interest) and some grants to owners and operators of sewer, water and stormwater systems for infrastructure improvements.
Governing Body:		A 13-member board of directors with Brian Regli, Ph.D as chairman designee.
Projects Approved:	*	3,436 (1,241 water; 1,817 wastewater; 197 NPS; 17 brownfield; 3 Acid Mine Drainage; 161 storm water)
Funding Approved:		\$12.2 billion (\$12,151,949,624)
